- · Assist the Awana ministry director in managing the budget.
- · Emcee and facilitate the club night.

Shepherd

- · Pray with the leaders and kids.
- · Assist leaders in communicating the gospel to children.
- · Model Christ-like leadership.
- · Encourage leaders to meet the spiritual needs of the children and youth in their care.
- · Motivate leaders to walk with Christ.
